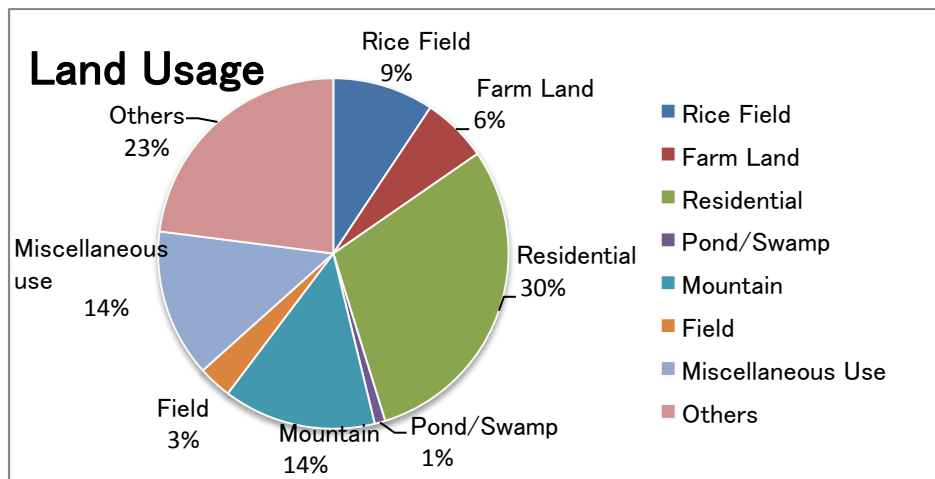
(3) Land Usage

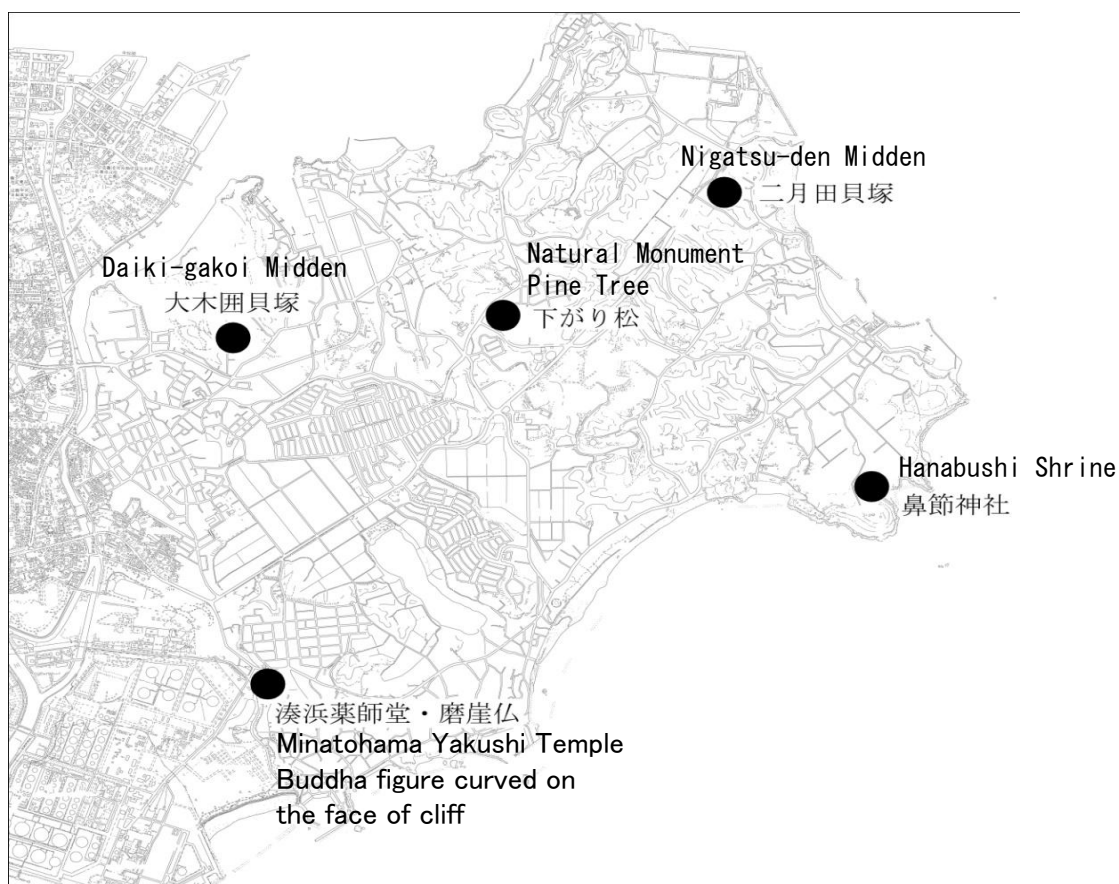

(4) Cultural Treasure and Historical Sites

There are about 40 locations of the middens from early Jomon period (approx. 15,000 years ago). Among them, Daiki-Gakoi has the area of 190,000m², and the largest one in Japan. It was registered as the National Important Cultural Property in 1968.
